Learning Objectives

Learning objectives reflect what learners will achieve by attending the course. Learning objectives should be written so that the learners know specifically what they should be able to do at the end of the course. Improperly written learning objectives may result in a course checklist being sent back for revisions. Learning objectives should:

- State the performance the learner should be able to accomplish.
- Specify the conditions under which the learner is to perform.
- Specify the criteria for acceptable performance.
- Directly related to the subject matter and content of the course.

Please avoid all vague language such as "Understand," "Knows," "Demonstrate Knowledge of," etc.
